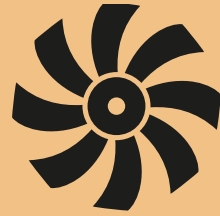


...our planet

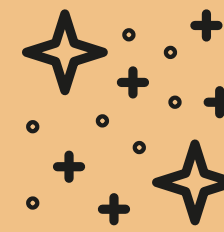

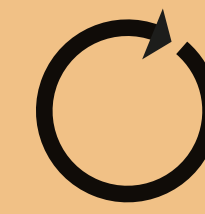

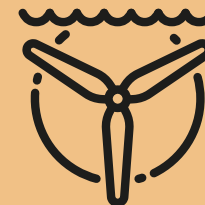
